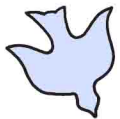


Jesus said that someone would come to be with His followers when He was gone.

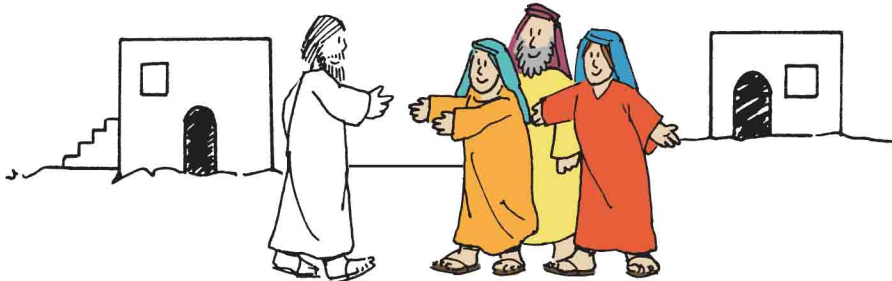
